Major Fixes and Enhancements

Component	Fix / Enhancement
Console	<p>Attribute Sync Cooling Period: A cooling period has been introduced for Attribute Sync, similar to Directory Sync. Once triggered, additional sync attempts during the defined interval (e.g., 5 minutes) are restricted, and an informative message is displayed.</p> <p>Access Policy Report (Managed Rules Inclusion): The Policy Status (Access Policy) report download now includes all configured managed rule entries linked to each policy. This ensures a complete and accurate representation of access policies for audit and compliance purposes.</p>
